## TOONGABBIE TOWNSHIP COMMUNITY PLAN October 2010

## Introduction

This plan has been developed with input from members of the Toongabbie community through a variety of means such as public forums, one on one consultations, community meetings and group meetings over a number of years. This plan was reviewed at a public forum held in October 2010, with the support of Latrobe City Council, and will be used to guide community action over the next 3 – 5 years.

The plan is intended to be *community owned and driven* and its purpose is to help:

- Provide a clearer direction of where the Toongabbie community wishes to be in the future
- Attract funding
- Attract volunteers and additional support
- Influence government planning and decisions
- Demonstrate to others that Toongabbie is an organised community

Implementation of the plan will be driven by community leaders and groups in Toongabbie as outlined in the table below under "Nominated Driver or Group". It is important that community effort is focused on ideas and activities that are achievable. Projects will need to be realistic and new community members may be required to step up and take leadership on some of these ideas. If no one is willing or able to drive the initiatives, then the idea may remain on hold until someone is able to offer the leadership to progress it.

The status of each project has been identified as either "In Progress", "To Be Initiated" or "On Hold" and classified as either "Very High", "High" or "Moderate" priorities. Projects which have been completed have been included in a separate table, at the end of this document, as a way of keeping a record of past community achievements.
